



### **Net Zero Investing in Practice – Challenges and Solutions**

To ensure a sustainable future, we must urgently address climate change. The inexorable rise in greenhouse gas emissions must be reversed, and rapid progress must be made globally towards net-zero greenhouse gas emissions to limit global warming to below 1.5°C. But this will not happen if left to governments alone - robust action by investors and businesses is essential.
